PUBLIC NOTICE

Pursuant to Nevada Revised Statutes (NRS) Chapter 445B, District Board of Health Regulations Governing Air Quality Management (DBOH Regulations), and the Clean Air Act, Northern Nevada Public Health Air Quality Management Division (AQMD) is issuing the following Notice of Proposed Action.

The AQMD received a complete application on 03/11/2025 for a Minor Source Air Quality Permit to Operate AAIR25-0001 from the following applicant:

MA Auto Body Shop
625 Quincy Street
Reno, Nevada 89512

MA Auto Body Shop is a facility with surface coating equipment, operating at 625 Quincy St., Reno, NV 89512 in Washoe County. The source is requesting to operate one (1) spray booth for small scale automotive painting.

A summary of the facility's emissions is shown below:

Based on the preliminary review of the information provided by the applicant and the requirements of the NRS, the DBOH Regulations and the Clean Air Act, the AQMD is hereby announcing their intent to issue the proposed Permit to Construct. A copy of this Notice of Public Action (NPA), the application, the draft Permit to Construct (PTC), and the Technical Support Document (TSD) will be available for public inspection at ourcleanair.com.

The application, TSD, proposed PTC, any comments received, and other relevant information may be copied at the above address or copies may be obtained by written request to the above address. Written comments or objections will be received at AQMD, above address, until June 29, 2025, and will be retained and considered prior to final action on the proposed Permit to Construct.

Any person may petition the AQMD in writing to hold a public hearing. If a proper petition is filed and the AQMD determines that there is a significant degree of public interest, the AQMD shall hold a public hearing no sooner than 30 calendar days, but no later than 70 calendar days, after the date of this Notice of Public Action. In determining if a significant degree of public interest exists, the AQMD shall consider all relevant factors, including, but not limited to, the number of petitioners, the nature of their concerns as stated in their petitions, and the type and quantity of emissions emitted by the source and the proximity of the source to sensitive areas such as parks, schools, hospitals, or residential areas. At least seven calendar days prior to the public hearing, notice of the public hearing shall be given to the petitioner, to the applicant, and to those listed in DBOH Regulations 030.200.E.3.a.(5) in the same manner as required for the NPA.
